To Whom It May Concern:

Maine Natural Gas (MNG) is currently scheduling Gas Demonstrations for 2017. The Gas Demonstrations can be scheduled at your convenience, including day and/or evening sessions, to ensure that all of your personnel have had the opportunity to attend. The total program, including questions and answers, is typically one and a half to two hours. The Gas demonstration covers the natural gas transportation system, the comparison of the properties of natural gas and propane, recognizing and responding to natural gas emergencies, and carbon monoxide. The properties compared are vapor density, heat content, ignition temperature and explosive limits. It includes controlled, live fire demonstrations.

The training is done as a public service and is designed to increase the awareness of public safety personnel that may be responding to natural gas emergencies. MNG looks forward to the opportunity to provide this training and respectfully requests that all members attend, including Chief Officers.
